SUBJECT: North District FFA Spring Eliminations

The North District FFA Eliminations will be held at Wallace State Community College-Hanceville on Friday, April 20, 2018 beginning at 9 a.m. You must complete a pre-registration form online by Noon on April 3, 2018 to participate. The link to the pre-registration is <https://goo.gl/forms/8CzadpjjioGjghqvx1>. You will also complete a registration form on-site to verify your online registration. The pre-registration link and on-site registration form have been posted, along with other pertinent documents, to the Calendar page of www.alabamaffa.org for your convenience.

When you pre-register, you will be agreeing to the new alternate policy for those events that allow alternates (Ag Construction & Maintenance, Ag Mechanics, Floriculture, Forestry, Horse Evaluation, Livestock, Nursery/Landscape, Poultry and Small Engines CDEs). Those CDEs not listed above along with all of the LDEs and both of the TDEs do not allow alternates to participate.

A program for the event has been posted to the Calendar page of www.alabamaffa.org for your review. It will take all of us working together to properly conduct these events. Please be ready to assist with the event to which you are assigned. Your cooperation and assistance is needed and will be appreciated. **Please contact me if you cannot attend the North District Eliminations for whatever reason.**

The Forestry CDE and Livestock CDE will be off-campus again this year and use two buses per event to transport students to the event sites. There will be three additional buses to transport teachers and students to event sites on campus.

Please make sure county-winning participants in the Safe Tractor Driving CDE have the proper Release of Liability Form completed and with them at the event site. **No Release Form – No Participation!**

Please see that your participants are at the Student Center Building, on time, and properly dressed for the occasion. Tobacco products are prohibited at all FFA events. We are proud of the behavior of our FFA members in the past, and I know we can count on the same excellent behavior this year. Lunch will be on your own. There are numerous food choices both on campus and in town. We will begin the awards ceremony at 2 p.m. sharp.
