### **WHAT IS THE WALL OF HONOR?**

The FFA Wall of Honor was designed to recognize individuals who have provided support and outstanding service to Alabama FFA and agriculture and is maintained by the Alabama FFA Foundation.

### **WHO SHOULD BE ADDED TO THE WALL OF HONOR?**

Individuals who have provided support and/or outstanding service to FFA or agriscience education on a local, state or national level should be added to the Wall of Honor.

### **HOW IS SOMEONE ADDED TO THE WALL OF HONOR?**

1. A minimum contribution of \$1,000 must be made to the Alabama FFA Foundation in honor or in memory of the person being recognized. Contributions can be made online by check or credit card at <https://bit.ly/30MCLsy>. ### **WHEN WILL NOMINEES BE ADDED TO THE WALL OF HONOR?**

Nominees will be recognized at a luncheon hosted at the Alabama Cattleman's Association during the Alabama FFA Convention. **The luncheon will be held on June 4, 2024 at 11:00 a.m.** For the nominee to be recognized at this year's State Convention, please submit the attached application and donation(s) by April 1. Each nominee will receive two luncheon tickets, additional tickets may be purchased for \$35 at <http://weblink.donorperfect.com/woh2025> (Luncheon tickets must be purchased by May 15.)

The nominator will be asked to give a brief introduction of the nominee at the luncheon and the nominee will be given a chance to speak, accepting the nomination. Following the luncheon, honorees will be recognized during the opening session of convention at the Montgomery Performing Arts Center.

### **CAN INDIVIDUALS BE ADDED TO THE WALL OF HONOR POSTHUMOUSLY?**

Yes. Normally a family member or close friend has accepted the honor on their behalf at the luncheon.
