

MINUTES OF MEETING OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

ALABAMA ASSOCIATION OF FUTURE FARMERS OF AMERICA

AUBURN, ALABAMA, JULY 11, 1935

The meeting of the Executive Committee of the Alabama Association of Future Farmers of America was called to order at 8:30 A. M. on Thursday, July 11, 1935, by Ernie Lee Robinson, President. The meeting was held in the agricultural class room of the Lee County High School. Those present were: Ernie Lee Robinson, President; Ennis Young, Vice-President; J. P. Dodd, Secretary; Seals Menefee, Treasurer; and Sammie Pate, Reporter.

MINUTES APPROVED

The Secretary read the minutes of the last meeting and on motion of Sammie Pate, seconded by Seals Menefee, and unanimously carried, they were approved.

FINAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR ANNUAL MEETING

The program for the annual meeting was gone over and each item carefully checked to see if everything was in readiness. The reports of the state officers to be given during the annual meeting were read and revised.

STATE FARMER DEGREE APPLICATIONS APPROVED

After carefully checking all applications for the State Farmer degree, 57 were approved for recommendation to the House of Delegates.

OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONIES

The Executive Committee practiced the opening and closing ceremonies for the state convention, and also the ceremony for raising candidates to the State Farmer degree.

BUDGET APPROVED

On motion of Ennis Young, seconded by J. P. Dodd, and unanimously carried, the attached budget was approved for the year 1935-36. Mr. Cammack was delegated authority to adjust any items in the budget to meet conditions which might arise during the year.

NEWS LETTER

Mr. Cammack presented a plan to the Committee for the publishing of a news letter next year with the suggestion that a committee be appointed to make further study and report back to the House of Delegates at sometime during the convention.

BOYS ELIGIBLE FOR STATE OFFICE

The matter of boys eligible for state office was thoroughly discussed. It was decided that out-of-school boys would not be considered for a state office, but that those in school who formerly took vocational agriculture and are not

now taking it because of schedule problems are eligible if qualified for a state office.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, on motion of Seals Menefee, seconded by Sammie Pate and unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned at 11:30 A. M.
