

2025 FFA Discussion Meet Questions

1. Successful FFA chapters build strong connections with their communities. What are some ways Alabama FFA chapters can work with local ag businesses, other school chapters in the district, and stakeholder organizations (such as the Alabama Farmers Federation) to create opportunities for members and promote agriculture?
2. One of FFA's goals is to help students prepare for careers in agriculture and beyond. What can chapters do to provide members with hands-on learning experiences, job shadowing, and mentorship opportunities that connect them to agricultural careers in Alabama?
3. Membership is key to a strong chapter. What strategies can FFA chapters use to recruit new members, especially those who might not have an agricultural background? How can chapters keep their members active and engaged throughout the year?
4. Passing leadership from one team of officers to the next is essential for chapter success. What can outgoing officers do to ensure the next group of leaders is prepared to take over? How can a smooth leadership transition help the chapter grow?
5. Leadership and service are cornerstones of FFA. What can chapters do to encourage more members to take on leadership roles or participate in service projects that benefit their schools and communities?
